AREA OF FOCUS - WATER AND SANITATION

1. TO RESTORE THE DEPLETING WATER TABLE 05 CLUBS PROPOSE TO INSTALL **RAIN WATER HARVESTING SYSTEMS** IN 15 SCHOOLS. EACH SYSTEM WILL REPLENISH THE WATER TABLE BY **AT LEAST 1 MILLION LITERS OF WATER ANNUALLY**. WATER METERS WILL MEASURE THE AMOUNT OF WATER REPLENISHED. **RECURRING COSTS NIL**. TOTAL PROJECT COST FOR ALL SCHOOLS INR 30,00,000/- **(PROJECT COST USD 42,900)**
2. RC HALDAUR PROPOSES TO **CONSTRUCT TOILET BLOCKS** FOR A CO-EDUCATIONAL SCHOOL HAVING 1600 STUDENTS. A VERY SMALL TOWN PRIMARILY ENGAGED IN AGRICULTURE ACTIVITIES. STUDENTS BELONG TO LOW STRATA GROUP. TOTAL PROJECT COST INR 17,56,100. OTHER CLUBS ARE ALSO THERE PROPOSING TOILET BLOCKS IN SCHOOLS WITH LOW STUDENT STRENGTH COST INR 5,15,900. **(PROJECT COST USD 32,000)**

AREA OF FOCUS – DISEASE PREVENTION & TREATMENT

1. RC MEERUT VIRAT, RC MEERUT MAHAN AND RC MORADABAD MID-TOWN PROPOSE TO VACCINATE 1000 GIRL STUDENTS IN THE AGE GROUP OF 11 TO 17 YEARS AGAINST **CERVICAL CANCER**. THEY SHALL ALSO CREATE AWARENESS ON FEMALE HYGIENE. THREE VACCINES SHALL BE ADMINISTERED TO EACH GIRL, FREE OF COST. COST PER STUDENT INR 5700 (USD 82). **(PROJECT COST USD 82,000)**
2. RC KHURJA PROPOSES TO INSTALL YAG LASER SYSTEM, AUTOCLAVE, LENS SET, COMPACT PHACO MACHINE, AUTOMATED CHAIR AND OTHER EQUIPMENT TO ALREADY RUNNING **ROTARY KHURJA EYE HOSPITAL**. THE HOSPITAL HAS BEEN SETUP WITH FUNDS FROM ROTARIANS AND MATCHING GRANTS. IT NEEDS THESE EQUIPMENT AS THE OPD NUMBERS HAVE INCREASED AND CURRENT EQUIPMENT ARE INSUFFICIENT TO CATER TO THE INFLOW. THE TOTAL PROJECT COST IS INR 50,00,000/- **(PROJECT COST USD 71,430)**
3. RC MORADABAD HERITAGE PROPOSES TO INSTALL A **RETINA SCREENING MACHINE** IN A CHARITABLE EYE HOSPITAL WITH AN **ANNUAL OPD OF 40,000**. THE MACHINE WILL ENABLE EARLY DETECTION OF RETINA DISEASE WHICH IS ON THE RISE DUE TO HIGH RATE OF DIABETES. THE FACILITY SHALL BE AVAIALBLE TO ALL THE PATIENTS AT NO EXTRA COST. THEY **HAVE A RETINA SPECIALIST ON THEIR PAYROLL**. ONLY ONE MACHINE IN THE CITY. PROJECT COST INR 33,50,000. **(PROJECT COST USD 47,183)**
4. 03 CLUBS PROPOSE TO PROVIDE AN **AMBULANCE** FOR SHIFTING PATIENTS FROM ONE PLACE TO OTHER AND ALSO TO SPECIALISED CENTERS IN METROS. SMALL AMBULANCE IS NEEDED FOR TRANSPORTATION FROM NARROW STREETS AND LANES. COST OF 3 AMBULANCES INR 24,00,000. **(PROJECT COST USD 33,800)**

AREA OF FOCUS – EDUCATION – HAPPY SCHOOLS

1. RC MORADABAD SANSKAR PROPOSE TO CONSTRUCT 2 TOILETS, RENOVATE 9 TOILETS, PLASTER WALLS AND ROOF, INSTALL SOLAR PANELS, ELECTRIC FITTINGS, DOORS, UPGRADE LABORATORIES AND PURCHASE BATTERY VEHICLES FOR TRANSPORTATION OF STUDENTS. SCHOOL HAS EXCELLENT TEACHING STAFF. TOTAL PROJECT COST INR 28,21,000. **(PROJECT COST USD 40,300)**
2. 5-6 CLUBS PROPOSE TO INSTALL 50KW SOLAR PANELS IN SCHOOLS TO ENSURE UNINTERUPTED POWER TO SCHOOLS HAVING ERATIC POWER SUPPLY **(PROJECT COST USD 40,000)**
