

GAVIOLI INTERNATIONAL AWARD 2022 – 2023

"IMAGINE FUTURE"

PUBLIC NOTICE FOR ADMISSION

The District 2042 of the Rotary International organizes, for the year 2022 - 2023 and within the Gavioli Film Festival of the District 2042, the 18th edition of the International cinematographic Award named after Roberto Gavioli.

The award is international, therefore it is also open to foreign Rotary clubs and to those twinned with Rotary Clubs of the Districts.

Registration and participation will be governed by this notice.

1. The Gavioli International Award:

- it is reserved for students attending upper secondary schools (or homologous educational institutions) presented by Rotarian supporting clubs;
- it requires, for the year 2022- 2023, the realization of short films on the theme "IMAGINE FUTURE";
- it is financially supported by Rotarian clubs, which will identify and involve schools and will pay for each one the participation fee of € 500.00 (see registration form).

2. District 2042 will provide students with highly qualified training tools free of charge.

A cycle of 5 lessons with compulsory attendance (masterclasses), will be held at the NABA -New Academy of Fine Arts in Milan; the main topics covered will be: Ideation, Film Language, Screenplay, Direction and Editing .

3. The original screenplays will originate the short films in compliance with the theme **"IMAGINE FUTURE"** assigned for the year.

4. Short films **must** be based on original subjects and screenplays; they **must** be characterized by the use of innovative, engaging and above all ironic expressive languages.

Each school can submit **only one short film** that has to

 be produced solely by students without interference from others, and must be assembled independently by the Institute (the Jury will not consider works that bring evident signs of intervention by teachers, parents or friends, or by experts in the professional production of films, as unfortunately happened in the past)

- have a maximum duration of 5 minutes; longer short films will not be accepted



- be transmitted by 15 April 2023 in digital format (.mp4) via WeTransfer to the address segreteria@rotary2042.it

5. They cannot be considered by the Jury: documentaries, music videos, commercial spots; short films considered offensive or detrimental to taste and morality are not allowed.

6. The intellectual property of the short films in competition belongs exclusively to the schools registered to participate in the Gavioli International Award: the institutes are responsible for the obligations connected with the copyright, the responsibility and the protection of the minors involved in the project, the image rights.

7. The Judgment of the Jury is unappealable.
